Entry Requirements

Students seeking to enter year 3 of the four year Leeds MEng programme are required to have successfully completed years 1 and 2 of their undergraduate studies at BIT or one of its International Centres and achieved the necessary English language standard eg 70% in CBSE XII examinations, IELTS 6.0, or equivalent.

Tuition Fees:

Students entering year three in 2007/8 will pay tuition fees of £11700 for that year. Fees rise slightly each year, and students should take this into account, when estimating the cost of their studies at Leeds.
